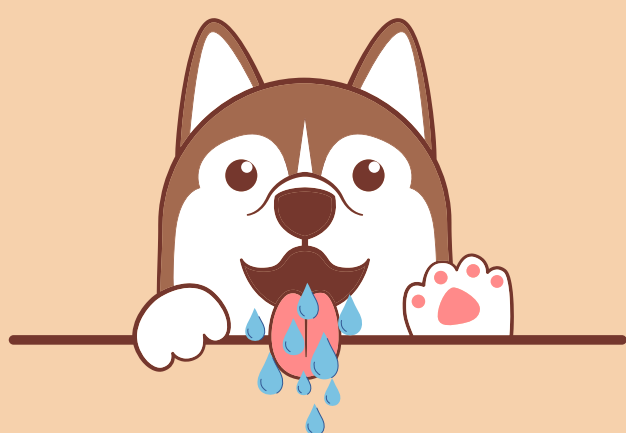


When you are asked to observe the animal,

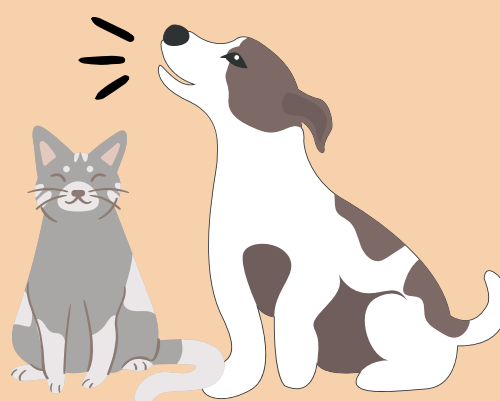
## **WATCH OUT FOR THE FOLLOWING CHANGES**

**Animals should be observed on daily basis by a reliable and competent person for 14 days for following signs**



- Any changes in behaviour of the animal
- Excessive salivation
- Dropped jaw

- Changes in the sound of the bark / meow
- Aggressive behavior
- Extremes excitability



- Fever, vomiting and inability to eat
- Seizures
- Biting in to inanimate objects

- Paralysis
- Frequent straining to urinate and/or defecate



**If you notice any of these changes in the animal that bit you, animal dies or goes missing within 14 days of being bitten, go to the hospital immediately !!!**
