• Field Epidemiology Training Programme

It is a residential, in-service training programme for Regional Epidemiologists and Medical Officers of Health.

- Conduct epidemiological investigations and field studies to understand and control outbreaks
- Conduct epidemiological and statistical analyses of large and complex datasets
- Provide public health information to the media and the public
- Present their work at scientific conferences and publish in peerreviewed journals
- Train other health professionals
